*Mrs. Kelly Korey*, mother of 3, has over 30 years experience teaching young children. This is Mrs. Korey's fourth year teaching at BHCP.

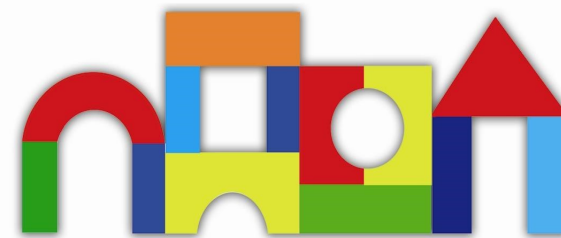
*Mrs. Kristy Lee*, mother of two, has degrees in Education and Speech Pathology. She joined BHCP in 2018.

# Mission Statement

The Beverly Heights Christian Preschool exists to provide a distinctively Christian preschool experience. Our program introduces young children to God and His love through activities appropriate to their age, while preparing them for kindergarten. These activities are planned and carried out by qualified, loving, Christian teachers. We strive to provide a setting where children develop mentally, physically, emotionally, socially and spiritually, much as the child Jesus “increased in wisdom and in stature, and in favor with God and man.” (Luke 2:52)

## Program

We have developed an integrated preschool curriculum. Each month, we focus on a theme that is educationally appropriate for preschoolers. Then, as we teach the theme, we relate it to God and His love and care for our children. For example, in October, our theme is “Fall.” We teach about the changes that the earth experiences at this time of year, and about how God, who designed these changes, cares for us throughout all the seasons.

Throughout the playtime and the more structured circle and art times, children learn to listen to the teachers, take turns, follow simple directions and learn self control. Our goal is to teach children about their world. They will develop their mental, physical, emotional, and social skills, while they learn who God is and how much He loves them.

## Older 4 Year Olds:

Mon, Wed, Thurs. & Fri. Afternoons 12:15 - 2:45 p.m

- ◆ Children should be 5 by February 1, 2022
- ◆ A weekly music class is part of the Older 4's class curriculum.

## Kindergarten Enrichment Class:

AM: Wednesday and/or Friday - 8:45 - 11:15 a.m.

PM: Wednesday and/or Friday - 12:30 - 3:00 p.m.

Option of 1 or 2 days per week

Class will start **October**, 2021

Child must be enrolled in Kindergarten to attend.

# School Year



Our

school year opens with a *Welcome Program* for 3 & 4 year old children and their parent on the first day of school. Classes begin after Labor Day and end before Memorial Day in May. A detailed calendar is included in the Parent Handbook which is distributed at the Welcome Program.

## Classroom Facilities

We have two classrooms on the lower level of the Beverly Heights Church. Each is filled with stimulating toys, reading corners, rice/water/sand tables, painting easels and a circle area for group instruction. We are equipped with an outdoor playground and an indoor exercise room for gross motor activities. The lower level has a security system in place that locks the doors after the children have arrived. The Parent 2's class meets in toddler rooms on the middle-level of Beverly Heights Church.

**Lunch 'n Fun:** In the 3's & 4's classes, for an additional cost, we offer a “Lunch ‘n Fun” program which extends our regular class day.
